

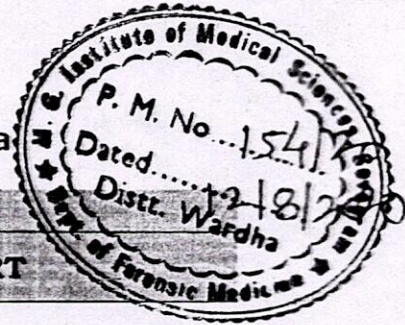

As per police inquest and history given by the relative of the deceased, the deceased was going in Auto on 11/08/2020 at around 3.30 PM when that Auto was knocked down by a four wheeler vehicle from behind. Auto rashed the divider and got overturned. The deceased was taken to Civil Hospital, Bhadravati from where after

primary treatment she was referred to Kasturba hospital, Sevagram where she got admitted on 11/08/2020 at 9.49 AM. But she succumbed to death on 12/08/2020 at 2.17 AM. Then, the body is brought by Sevagram police for post-mortem examination to know the cause of death.

7. Sex, apparent age, race or cast: Female / 58 Yrs. / Hindu.

Description of clothes & ornaments on the body: Green violet coloured *lugga*, dark violet coloured blouse.

8. Condition of the clothes: Whether wet with water, stained with blood or soiled with vomit or faecal matter: - Not applicable.

9. Special marks on the skin such as scars, tattooing etc., any malformations peculiarities, or other marks of identification. state of the teeth: Identified body. Both hands contains green coloured bangles. Tattoo mark present on the left hand dorsal aspect with pointed design. Nose contains bindi metallic gold with mangalsutra.

- Eyes are closed.
- Mouth is closed. Tongue is inside the oral cavity.
- There are signs of bleeding from the nostrils, ears and mouth.

If bruise be present what is the condition of the subcutaneous tissues? 1. Obliquely placed contused lacerated wound of size 10 cm with 8 intact sutures present of right knee joint and lower 1/3rd of femur. On opening margins were contused and irregular of size 10 cm × 2 cm × bone deep with underlying bone fracture seen.
2. Left knee joint shows contused abrasion of size 5×4 cm which is reddish brown in colour.
3. Abrasions present on Anterior aspect of right thigh, lower 1/3rd of size 2×1 cm and upper 1/3rd of leg anteriorly of size 2×1 cm and medial aspect of lower 1/3rd of leg of size 3×1 cm. Surface is reddish brown in colour.

18. Other injuries discovered by external examination or palpation as fractures etc } Lower 1/3rd of right femur shows fracture.

(a) Can you say definitely that the injuries shown against serial Nos. 17 and 18 are ante-mortem injuries } Yes, Antemortem.

III: Internal Examination:-

19. Head:

- a. *Injuries under the scalp, their nature:* No evidence of any injury under the scalp.
- b. *Skull- Vault and base: Describe fractures, their sites, dimensions, directions etc.:* No evidence of any fracture over the vault / base.
- c. *Brain- The appearance of its coverings, size, weight, and general condition of the organ itself and any abnormality found in its examination to be carefully noted:*
On removing the vault, dura matter and falx cerebri are intact. Meninges are intact.
Brain is soft, oedematous and pale on cut section. Weight of the brain is 1160 gm.

20. Thorax:

- a. *Walls, ribs, cartilages:* Intact.
- b. *Pleura:* Intact.
- c. *Larynx, Trachea and Bronchi:* Trachea is pale and contains minimal amount of blood. Mucosa congested.
- d. *Right Lung:* } Both the lungs are normal in size, shape and appearance. Weight of
e. *Left Lung:* } the right lung is 250 gm and that of the left lung is 300 gm. There is
minimal amount of blood seen oozing out from both the lungs on cut
section.
- f. *Pericardium:* Normal.
- g. *Heart with weight:* The heart is normal in size and shape. There is no evidence of hemorrhage, necrosis and any valvular pathology. The Heart is 250 gm in weight and is filled with minimal amount of blood.
- h. *Large vessels:* Intact, patent.
- i. *Additional remark:* Nil

21. Abdomen:

- *Walls:* Intact externally.
- *Peritoneum:* Intact. No evidence of free fluid.
- *Cavity:* All the organs are in situ.
- *Buccal cavity, teeth, tongue and pharynx:* Teeth are intact and 16/16 in number.
- *Oesophagus:* Normal in size and shape. Pale on cut section.
- *Stomach and its contents:* The stomach is distended and contains approximately 100 ml of yellowish coloured semi-liquid material is present with no evidence of any peculiar smell. The mucosa is pale.

- *Small intestine and its contents:* Contains about 200 gm of yellowish coloured semi-solid matter. No evidence of any peculiar smell. Mucosa is pale.
 - *Large intestine and its contents:* Distended with gases and minimal faecal matter.
 - *Liver (with weight) and gall bladder:* Liver is normal in size, shape and appearance. There is no evidence of any focal lesion. It is congested on cut section. Gall bladder is filled with bile. Liver weight =1050 gm.
 - *Pancreas and Suprarenals:* Both are normal in size & shape. Pale on cut section.
 - *Spleen with weight:* It is normal in size and shape and pale on cut section. Weight-90 gm.
 - *Kidney with weight:* Both the kidneys are normal in size and shape. Weight of the right kidney is 100 gm and that of the left kidney is 110 gm. The cut surface of both the kidneys reveal well-defined corticomedullary ratio and pale.
 - *Urinary Bladder:* Intact, unremarkable and is empty.
 - *Organs of generation:* Normal.
 - *Additional remarks with where possible, medical officer's deduction from the state of the contents of the stomach as to time of death and last meal:* Nil
 - *State which viscera (if any) have been retained for chemical examination and also quote the numbers on the bottles containing the same:* Nil.
22. **Spine and Spinal Cord:* Spine shows fracture at L3-L4 and L5 level which is linear, transverse with infiltration of blood seen surrounding fracture. Spinal cord shows reddish coloured contusion of size 4x2 cm in the region of fracture with effusion of blood.

"Cardio respiratory failure due to Traumatic fracture of right femur with injury to spine and haemorrhage (Unnatural)".
